The Palo Alto County Board of Supervisors met in regular session. Members present: Craig Merrill, Chair, Linus Solberg, Ron Graettinger, Keith Wirtz and Ed Noonan.

Unless otherwise indicated, all of the motions offered at this meeting were carried with the following vote: Ayes: Noonan, Wirtz, Graettinger, Solberg, Merrill. Nays: None. Abstentions: None.

Motion by Graettinger, seconded by Wirtz to approve agenda for July 14th, 2015. Motion carried.

Motion by Noonan, seconded by Wirtz to approve the minutes of July 7<sup>th</sup>, 2015. Motion carried.

Motion by Graettinger, seconded by Solberg to approve the Recorder's monthly report for June 1, 2015, thru June 30, 2015. Motion Carried.

Maureen Sandberg, CPC, met with the Board. The Board received copies of the regional governance board meeting minutes for June 25, 2015.

Walter Davis-Oeth, County Engineer, met with the Board to recommend approval of utility permits. Walter gave update on road patching and edging on roads.

Motion by Solberg, seconded by Wirtz to approve utility permit application for Iowa Lakes Electric Cooperative in Nevada Township, Sections 4 & 5. Motion Carried.

Motion by Solberg, seconded by Noonan to approve utility permit application for Iowa Lakes Electric Cooperative in Great Oak Township, Sections 16 & 21. Motion Carried.

Motion by Solberg, seconded by Noonan to approve utility permit application for Iowa Lakes Electric Cooperative in Vernon Township, Sections 5 & 8. Motion Carried.

Motion by Graettinger, seconded by Noonan to approve utility permit application for Windstream Iowa Communication, Inc. to place cable across 430<sup>th</sup> Ave in Emmetsburg Township, Section 3 & 4. Motion Carried.

Dave Pettit, Cylinder Fire Department, met with the Board to request getting fuel at county shed for fire trucks. Engineer's Office will set this up.

Jason Frederick met with the Board to address concerns about engine brake noise on the new bypass road. The Board recommended that Jason put a sign on his property. The county will have a light installed at the intersection of the new bypass road and Hwy 4.

Don Etler, Bolton & Menk, Inc. met with the Board to file the Engineer's Report for Proposed Drainage Improvements on Drainage District 28. Present: Wade Lundgren; Amber Brownell, Auditor's Office. The total estimated assessable project cost is \$ 2,150,000. There are currently 2,762 assessed acres in the district. There are 4,066 benefitted acres. Motion by Wirtz, seconded by Graettinger to set an informal hearing on Drainage District 28 for August 11<sup>th</sup>, 2015, at 1:00 p.m. at the Election Center. Motion Carried.

Lynn Schultes, County Sheriff, met with the Board to continue discussion on adding one full-time jailer and one full-time communication center position. Lynn presented the total estimated cost of \$28,136 for the additional \$4.00 per hour for part-time staff based on paid hours for last year. No action taken.

Robin Jamison, County Treasurer, met with the Board to present the Treasurer's Semi-Annual Report. Motion by Solberg, seconded by Noonan to approve the Treasurer's Semi-Annual Report for January 1, 2015 to June 30, 2015. Motion Carried.

Motion by Graettinger, seconded by Wirtz to approve hiring Sheri Freeman as Clerk in the Auditor's Office at \$34,000 annual salary effective July 27, 2015. Motion Carried.

Motion by Graettinger, seconded by Solberg to approve \$5,000 for 1 year to Iowa Drainage District Association for funding legal defense against Des Moines Waterworks. Ayes: Graettinger, Solberg. Nays: Wirtz, Noonan, Merrill. Motion failed.

Motion by Noonan, seconded by Wirtz to introduce and approve the following Resolution 7-14-2015 for funding in FY16-17. Ayes: Noonan, Wirtz, Merrill. Nays: Graettinger, Solberg. Resolution passed.

# RESOLUTION

7-14-2015

Whereas, the Des Moines Waterworks has filed suit under the Clean Water Act against drainage districts in Buena Vista, Calhoun and Sac Counties, and;

Whereas, the suit would seek to regulate agricultural practices which are currently exempt from regulation under the Clean Water Act, and;

Whereas, the suit, if successful would impose regulatory burdens upon drainage districts and the landowners in those districts, and;

Whereas, the suit, if successful, would require drainage district trustees to exercise powers that are not legally available to them under existing state law, and;

Whereas, the suit would irreparably harm drainage rights, operations and row crop production in this county, and;

Whereas, it is recognized that the suit, while filed against a small number of districts would, if successful, be applicable to all districts in Iowa and in other states, and;

Whereas, it is recognized that a strong legal defense must be made against the lawsuit, and;

Whereas, it would be in the best interests of Iowa counties to directly support the legal defense of the drainage districts in Buena Vista, Calhoun and Sac Counties and to have the Iowa Drainage District Association participate in the case if requested by Belin McCormick Law Firm, the attorneys retained by Buena Vista, Calhoun and Sac Counties, in order to represent the interests of all drainage districts in Iowa.

Now, therefore be it resolved that the Palo Alto County Board of Supervisors pledges financial support to help fund the legal defense of the drainage districts in Buena Vista, Calhoun and Sac Counties; and it is understood that IDDA will disperse said monies to Buena Vista, Calhoun and Sac Counties at their request.

Now, therefore be it further resolved that the financial support will be in the amount of \$5,000/year for three years payable to the IDDA litigation fund for the legal defense of the drainage districts in Buena Vista, Calhoun and Sac Counties. If the lawsuit is resolved in a prompt fashion and the second or third years of the financial support is not necessary, the IDDA board will notify the county that the additional financial support is not necessary.
