

PALO ALTO COUNTY SECONDARY ROAD DEPARTMENT TEMPORARY EMBARGO PERMIT

321.471 Code of Iowa

Palo Alto County restricts by resolution vehicles operating on secondary roads. The gross vehicle weight is restricted to protect the road from damage or destruction for up to 90 days in the calendar year. Violators are subject to a fine per the Code of Iowa. Vehicles are not allowed to exceed legal weight limits or restricted bridge weight limits regardless of holding a permit. This permit expires 8 weeks from the date of issuance. ***This permit and attached map shall be carried in the permitted vehicle while it is operating on the embargoed road sections and shall be shown to any peace officer upon request.***

PALO ALTO COUNTY EMBARGO PERMIT

321.471 Code of Iowa

- 1) All time loss encountered by county crews due to damaged roadway or structure will be charged to the permit holder involved. All repair work performed by county crews, necessitated because of the hauling on an embargoed road, will be charged to the permit holder.
- 2) The County assumes no responsibility for damages to the permittee's vehicle or property occasioned by any travel on said roadway.
- 3) The permittee shall take all reasonable precaution during the hauling on an embargoed road to protect and safeguard the lives and property of the traveling public and adjacent property owners and shall save the County harmless of any damages or losses that may be sustained by the traveling public or adjacent property owners of such operations.
- 4) The permittee shall hold the County harmless from any damage that may result to said roadway because of the hauling during an embargo and shall reimburse the County for any expenditure that the County may make due to the permittee's actions.
- 5) The permittee shall provide the county with a proof of insurance indicating the policy limits and naming Palo Alto County as an additional insured on the policy. Minimum policy limits are as follows:

Bodily Injury: \$500,000 Each Occurrence
\$1,000,000 Aggregate

Property Damage: \$500,000 Each Occurrence
\$1,000,000 Aggregate
