Palo Alto County, November 2, 2021

Voter ID Required: As of January 1, 2019, all voters are required to present an approved form of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a ballot.

Approved Forms of ID: Iowa Driver's License; Iowa Non-Operator ID; U.S. Passport; U.S. Military ID or Veteran ID; Iowa Voter Identification Card; Tribal ID Card/Document.

- 1. Wednesday, October 13:** In-person absentee voting begins at the County Auditor's office, 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. & ends on Monday, November 1, 2021, at 4:00 p.m.
- 2. Vote by mail** by submitting an absentee ballot request form. Forms must be received by 5 p.m. on **Monday, October 18**. **Find the absentee ballot request form at:** <https://sos.iowa.gov/>. Voted Absentee ballots must be received in your County Auditor's Office prior to 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.
- 3. Satellite Absentee Voting Stations on October 13, at the Mallard Community Center and Ruthven Social Center; 1:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.**

Tuesday, November 2, 2021: Polls Open 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Vote at your assigned polling place at Graettinger Public Library, West Bend Public Library or Emmetsburg Election Center.
