The Board of Supervisors intends to fill the vacancy by appointment per Code of Iowa 69.14A, Subsection 2. The electors of the county have the right to file a petition requiring that the vacancy be filled by special election. The petition is due within fourteen (14) days from the date of this notice or fourteen (14) days from the date of appointment. The Board of Supervisors has set September 1, 2022, at 8:00 a.m. at the Courthouse Boardroom as the date, time, and place to fill the vacancy of the County Sherriff.

Motion by Solberg, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Graettinger to appoint John D. King as Palo Alto County Sheriff to fill the vacancy through December 31, 2024. Motion Carried.

The Public Notice of appointment will be published on September 8, 2022.

#### PUBLIC NOTICE

The Palo Alto County Board of Supervisors has appointed John D King to fill the vacancy in the Palo Alto County Sheriff's Office effective September 1, 2022.
